

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to update you with the news that Massachusetts students will receive FREE school meals in School Year 2023-2024 and in all future years! Massachusetts became the 8th state to make School Meals for All permanent. The universal free school meals program offers one breakfast and lunch at no charge to all students regardless of income.

For students who choose to bring their own breakfast or lunch from home, milk is available for purchase for \$0.60. Milk only is an A La Carte item and is not included under the universal free school meals program.

Please note that even though meals will be free for all, it is very important for families to still complete the household Application for Free and Reduced Price Meals for the 2023-2024 school year.

We strongly encourage all families to submit the application as it allows us to serve families most effectively and helps getting more money for other school programs. The information you provide is confidential. We follow strict federal rules to keep your information private.



The account is opened in the child's name, as well as the parent/guardian's name and both signatures are required to complete a withdrawal. In the month the student turns 19, the account will automatically convert to a Get Real Statement Savings Account. This will be a joint account requiring one (1) signature for withdrawals and will be subject to the fees and requirements applicable to the Get Real Statement Savings Account.
