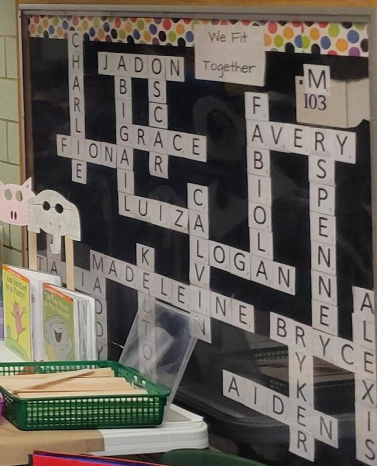
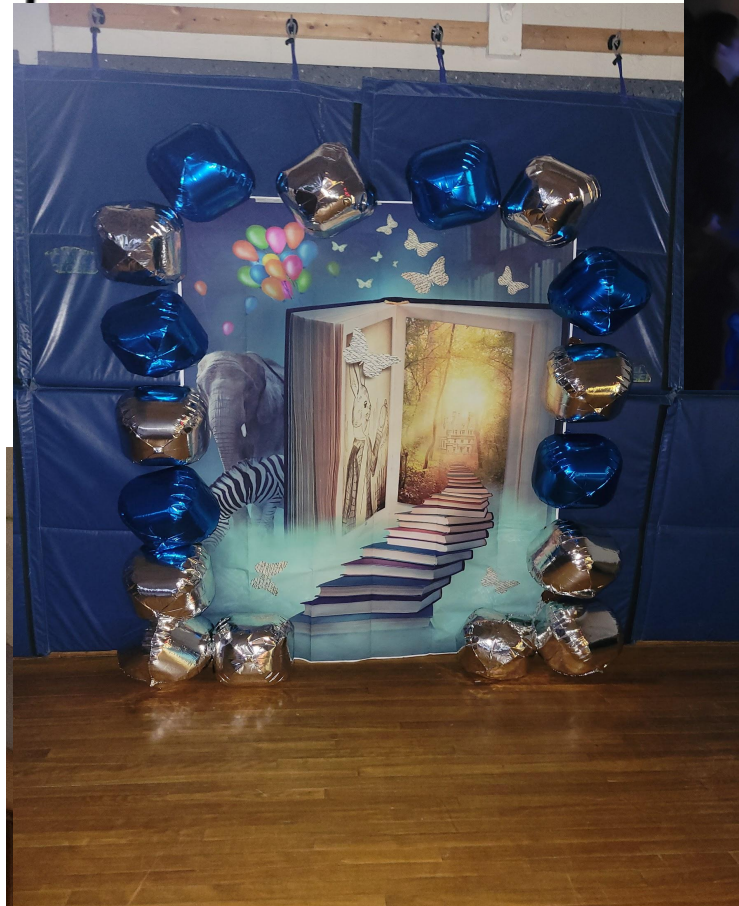

West Boylston Child Find

WEST BOYLSTON - The schools wish to identify all West Boylston children with disabilities, ages 3 to 21 years, who may be in need of special education services, and who have not graduated from high school.

Additionally, the school district wishes to identify any children who may be currently homeless and therefore have certain educational rights under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act.

The McKinney-Vento Act was reauthorized by Congress in 2001 under the No Child Left Behind Act. It defines homeless children as those "who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence."

Anyone who can identify a child with a disability or a child without a permanent home who is not receiving educational services, should have the parents or any interested person contact Kristen Nasuti at 508-834-4461.

Pre-School Screening

WEST BOYLSTON - The West Boylston Public Schools will conduct a pre-school screening for all children ages 2½ to 4 years old on May 29, 2024, by appointment only.

It is the policy of the West Boylston Public Schools to screen all students 2 ½ to 4 years old who may be in need of special education services, when requested by the parents.

WEST BOYLSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS INTEGRATED PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

The West Boylston Public Schools is taking applications for the preschool program for the 2024 – 2025 school year.

The four-day preschool program for 3 and 4-year-olds runs 4 days a week.

The morning session runs from 8:30 – 11:00 AM, and the afternoon session runs from 12:00 PM to 2:30 PM. There is no session on Wednesdays.

Children must be 3 years old by August 31, 2024. Tuition is \$2,000 for the school year

The five-day preschool program for 4 and 5-year-olds runs 5 days a week.

The morning session runs from 8:30 – 11:00 AM, and the afternoon session runs from 12:00 PM to 2:30 PM.

Children must be 4 years old by August 31, 2024. Tuition is \$2,500 for the school year

The five-day full-day preschool program for 4 and 5-year-olds runs 5 days a week.

The program runs from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM.

Children must be 4 years old by August 31, 2024. Tuition is \$5000 for the school year

The preschool program begins the Thursday after Labor Day (9/5/24) and goes until the last day of school on the West Boylston school calendar.

Placement is through a lottery held on April 1, 2024.

This lottery is for in-town residents only.

Available openings will be offered to non-residents through a second lottery held on May 15, 2024.

Preschool is not part of the school choice program.

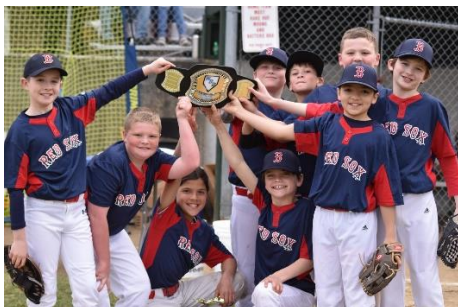

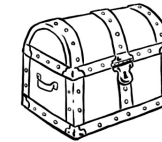
Love to READ!!!

Tuesday, February 13th- "Read a Shirt Day!": Wear a school appropriate shirt with words that can be **read** by others.

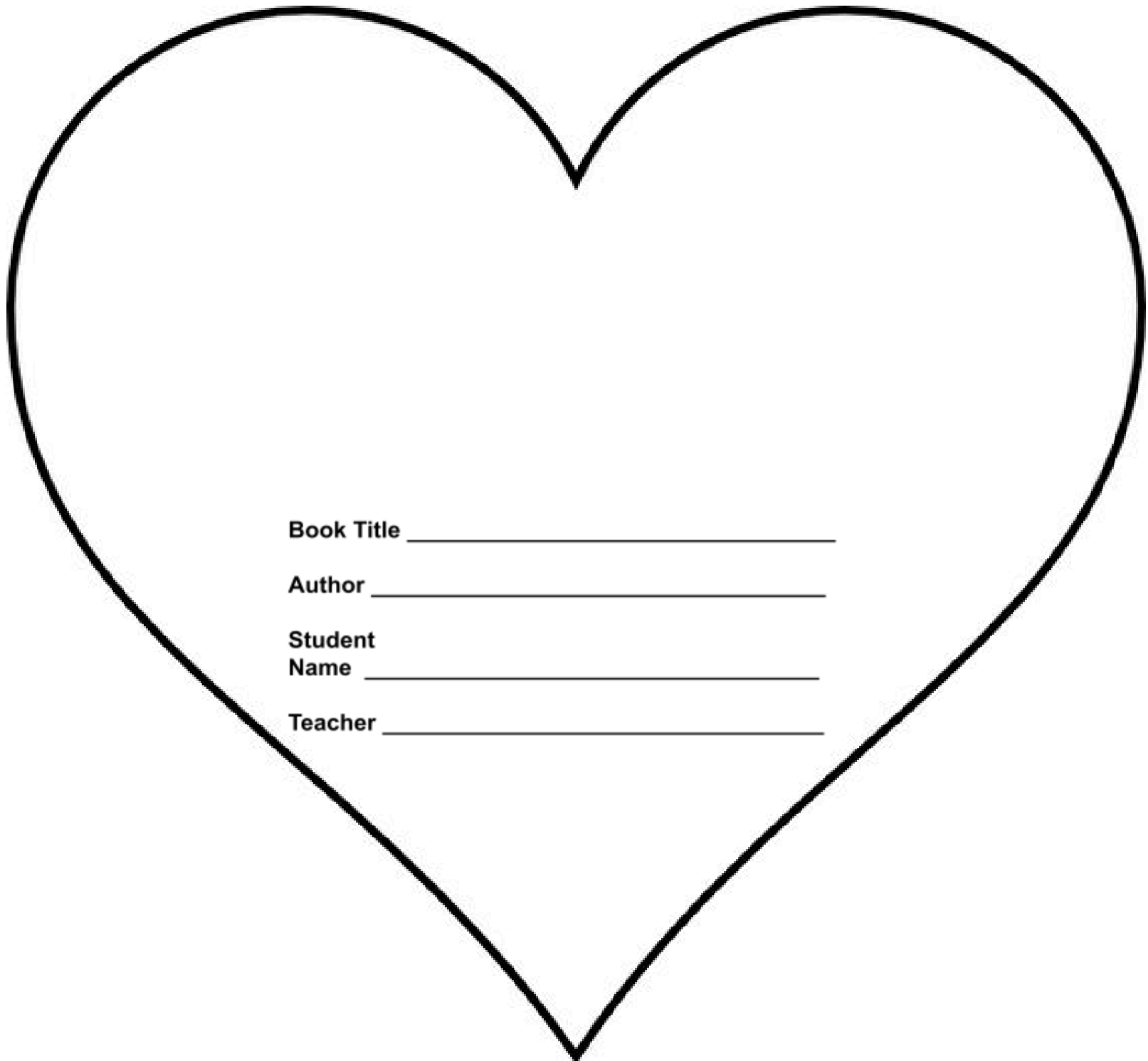
Wednesday, February 14th- "I Love to Read Day!": Wear some red or hearts to promote the **love** of **reading**.

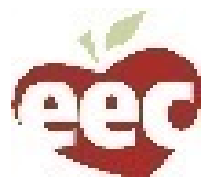
