8. BUDGET PLANNING: Public Hearing March 11, 2015

Dr. Schaper indicated the Public Hearing regarding the FY16 Budget would be scheduled for March 11, 2015 and would be published in the newspaper a month before the meeting date.

9. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

- a. Negotiations Ms. Palumbo stated that interest based bargaining had been discussed with regards to negotiations as opposed to the collective style of bargaining that has been used previously for the Teachers' Union.
- b. Policy Ms. Breen indicated there were five (5) policies included in the School Committee packet that would be reviewed in anticipation of a first reading at next month's School Committee meeting.
- c. Capital Projects/School Building Mr. Pedone stated the subcommittee had met today to discuss the ABM project. He indicated ABM would get back to the subcommittee regarding the heat and maintenance plan in place at Major Edwards Elementary School. Mr. Pedone also mentioned a Statement of Interest had been sent to the District by the state. Discussion ensued regarding a needs based analysis study.

- a. Edwards Elementary Principal Mr. Meagher reported on ABM's efforts to regulate temperature and noise from the radiators, the Spellathon that raised approximately \$9,400.00 for the PTA and the WSRS teacher of the month Ms. Pepi.
- b. Middle School Associate Principal Mr. LaBreck thanked the 6th grade team, Ms. Spencer and students for their 5th grade information night which was held on January 13th. He stated that current 8th graders have received a letter stating that they have been selected to participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP).
