We will utilize a number of strategies including online learning, SmartMusic, and in-person rehearsing (with safe socially distancing). I am determined to help students gain an outlet for expression and a way to learn an instrument.

- one (1) pair concert snare drum sticks (5A, 2BN or similar)
- one (1) snare drum practice pad

Bi-Weekly Meeting Schedule

Percussion ensemble will meet once every other week (bi-weekly). I will hold meetings/rehearsals for beginning percussionists last period during your cohort's special time. During these rehearsals we will play a variety of school percussion instruments (using our own sticks). Percussionists will learn about bell/keyboard instruments and struck/battery percussion. We will <u>not</u> learn drumset in this ensemble. Meeting groups and times will be sent out once the ensemble numbers are finalized. Activities will be assigned throughout the week.

SmartMusic Computer Program

Every percussion student will have access to their own SmartMusic account that they will use throughout the year. With SmartMusic students will be able to do the following:

- Look through a variety of FREE music that will appear on your computer screen
- Access a method book
- Listen to the method books songs played by your instrument
- Play along with a background track for many exercises
- Record yourself playing along with the file
- Get INSTANT feedback on what notes and rhythms were played correctly

Information and video instruction on setting up your SmartMusic account will be sent to students who register for band.

Creating a Practice Schedule

Students will be asked to practice material at home. Students should talk to parents and family members about good practice times and places. I would strongly suggest that students and parents discuss a routine time and place to practice a few times a week. Consistent schedules will help students develop strong practice habits and skills. I would expect a 4th grade percussion student to practice 10 minutes, 2-3 days a week. An example practice schedule would be MWF 3:30-3:40pm.
