Leominster CTEi application process

The West Boylston Public Schools offers vocational opportunities for West Boylston residents through a preferred vocational partnership with the Leominster Center for Technical Education Innovation School. West Boylston residents who wish to pursue a vocational program of studies in high school will apply to CTEI for admission. Transportation, at no cost to the student, will be provided for West Boylston residents attending the programs at CTEI.

Students may select from any of CTEI's twelve Chapter 74 approved programs including automotive technology, carpentry, collision repair, culinary arts, drafting, electrical, electronics, graphic communications, health occupations, HVAC, machine technology/robotics, and plumbing.

Admission Timeline for 8th-grade students

November: Leominster CTEi staff will come to West Boylston to do a presentation for the entire 8th grade

December/January: West Boylston staff will bring students who are interested, on a tour of Leominster CTEi during the school day

February-March: Application for admission will be made available to students, provided by the guidance office

March: Leominster holds an open house for interested parents and students

April: Application is due back to the school, reviewed by the superintendent and submitted to Leominster for admission determination

May: Acceptances will go out to families, Leominster will contact each family about next steps including student registration and course selection for freshman year
